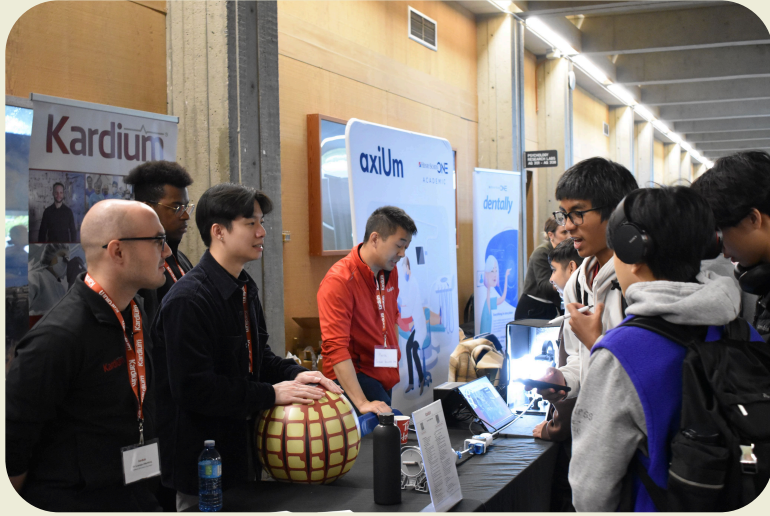

## Fall Hacks

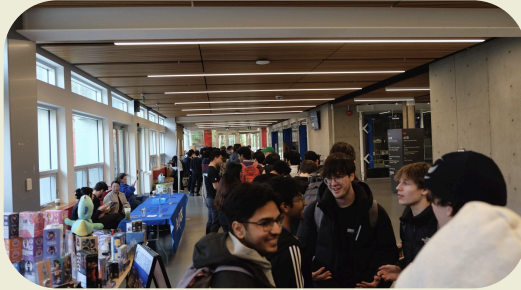
